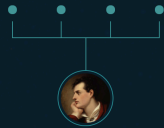

Backus Smart Contracts

John Warner Backus (December 3, 1924 – March 17, 2007) was an American computer scientist. He directed the team that invented and implemented FORTRAN, the first widely used high-level programming language, and was the inventor of the Backus-Naur form (BNF), a widely used notation to define formal language syntax.

Bashō (Performance improvement)

Matsuo Bashō (松尾 芭蕉 1644-1694), born 松尾 金作, then Matsuo Chūemon Munefusa (松尾 忠右衛門 宗房),^{[2][3]} was the most famous poet of the Edo period in Japan. During his lifetime, Bashō was recognized for his works in the collaborative haikai no renga form; today, after centuries of commentary, he is recognized as the greatest master of haiku (then called hokku).
