ANNUAL TUTORING RATES FOR 2023

Fees are calculated at a starting rate of \$45 per hour for **Private Online Tutoring**, and \$55 per hour for **Private In-person Tutoring** services. No further fees shall be charged for the traveling or preparation time of the Tutor. Cornerstone Learning Solutions also reserves the right to change tutoring rates at any given time with prior notice. For **Online Group Tutoring** rates, please contact info@clsaca.org.

FEES PAYABLE

Fees are payable to Cornerstone Learning Solutions Inc.

PAYMENT

A credit/debit will be required at the time of sign-up. You will not be charged until the last tutoring session of the week.

LATE PAYMENT

Failure to submit payments on time will incur a late fee of \$10. Please communicate any potential delinquencies to Cornerstone Learning Solutions Administrators, not the Tutor, to avoid a late payment fee.

CANCELLATIONS

Sessions canceled without giving 24 hours prior notice to the Tutor or our Office Staff shall be charged the full hourly rate unless otherwise noted per Admins approval. If the Tutor cancels a session for any reason, you will not be charged.

PREPAYMENT & REFUNDS

We accept prepayments. If you cancel a prepaid session for any reason, the prepaid amount will not be refunded but instead applied as a credit to the next session attended. However, if the Tutor cancels a session, you will have the option to either apply your prepayment to a future session or request a refund for the canceled prepaid session.

FEES PAYABLE

Fees are calculated according to the scheduled time agreed upon by the Tutor and Parent. Any time lost shall be compensated for by extending a session. If there is a conflict with extending a session with the Tutor, the Parent/Guardian/Representative may reschedule to make up for time lost at no additional charge.

STATUS OF THE TUTOR

It is understood that the Parent retains the Tutor's services as an employee of Cornerstone Learning Solutions.

TERMINATION OF EMPLOYMENT

Cornerstone Learning Solutions reserves the right to terminate the employment relationship at any time and for any lawful reason.

RELAXATION OF TERMS

No relaxation, indulgence, waiver, or release by any party of any of the rights in terms of this agreement on one occasion shall prevent the subsequent enforcement of such rights and shall not be waived of any subsequent breach of any terms.

WHOLE AGREEMENT

This agreement constitutes the entire understanding between the parties regarding the subject matter hereof. The parties waive the right to rely on any alleged expressed or implied provision not contained herein. Any alteration to this agreement must be in writing and signed by both parties.

OBLIGATIONS OF THE PARENT/GUARDAIN/REPRESENTATIVE

1. The student(s) undertakes to assist the Tutor in identifying problem areas for that tutoring is needed.
2. The student(s) agrees to provide their materials for each tutoring session (E. g., paper, pencil, etc.).
3. The student(s) agrees that assignments, exercises, or homework are integral to tutoring and undertakes to complete such work timeously.
4. The Parent/Guardian/Representative agrees that he/she is to be present at all tutoring sessions of minors or adult student(s) with disabilities.

5. The Parent/Guardian/Representative agrees and understands that any delinquencies of payment for tutoring will result in cancellation.
6. The Parent/Guardian/Representative agrees any sessions not attended by the student(s) without giving 24 hours prior notice to the Tutor or Cornerstone Learning Solutions shall be charged at the full rate.
7. The Parent/Guardian/Representative agrees and understands that any prepaid amount will not be refunded but instead applied to the next session attended by the student(s) unless the tutor cancels a prepaid session.
8. The Parent/Guardian/Representative agrees any time lost shall be compensated for by extending a session.
9. The Parent/Guardian/Representative agrees that if there is a conflict with extending a session with the Tutor, they may reschedule to make up for time lost.
10. The Parent/Guardian/Representative understands the Tutor makes no promises or warranties regarding a student(s)'s performance due to any tutoring provided.
11. The Parent/Guardian/Representative understands that either party may terminate this tutoring contract by giving the other party seven days prior written notice.
