

My Favourite Movie Genres

This article will discuss which movie genres are my favourite movie genres and why. I will examine what each category represents to me individually and together as a whole. Also, I will provide an easy way to categorize your favourite movie genres into categories that are more easily defined.

So you're looking for a great film and you may even get some surprises. With dramas you get movies such as Invictus, The Pursuit of Fire, Man on the Moon, Good Will Hunting, Casino, Scarface, Inglourious Basterds, Training Day and many more!

I don't want to leave out horror as a movie genre to talk about here. This is another broad category that you could go with when choosing a movie. I love scary films and you can usually find plenty of them. Examples are The Shining, Halloween, and The Exorcist. Other horror films include Hostel and The Purge.

Finally when it comes to my favourite movie genre, there are three to choose from: comedy, drama, and horror. If you don't like any of these, you can always choose the widest category that fits what you're looking for. You can also watch a film from each of the three main genres all throughout the year. So which films fit into which category? In order to answer that question we need to break down the film into segments. Take For example the first segment is the beginning and the end of the film. In this category you'll find a few obvious choices like Citizen Jones, Jaws, etc. But what about the middle? Will the likes of Grease, E.T, or Saturday Night Fever fit into this section?

To tell which films fit in which category you'll have to look at the last few minutes or so of the film. These are the crucial moments in the film where you can decide whether the film is a comedy, drama, or horror. If the last few minutes are entirely laugh out loud funny, then it is definitely comedy. But if there is one shot of serious conflict going on, then this again will be classified under drama.

You may even find that your favourite films are not in any particular genre. There was a moment in all my films, or at least my favourite films, when I almost cried. This is because I had totally forgotten about the third act, or climax. But once I reeled in and understood what was going on I realised that the whole film was about a love story between two young lovers who were barely aware of the world around them.

It all comes down to personal choice and preference. Some of my favourite movie genres are comedy, drama, horror and films about children (Wreck-It Ralph, Toy Story, etc.). There are others too, but my favourites are the big budget, blockbuster type films.
