#### 4. Take a timeout

#### 5. Identify possible solutions

#### 8. Use humor to release tension





#### Legal Measures and Support Systems:


Governments and legal systems worldwide are increasingly recognizing the need for robust legislation to combat revenge porn. Many countries have implemented or are in the process of implementing




