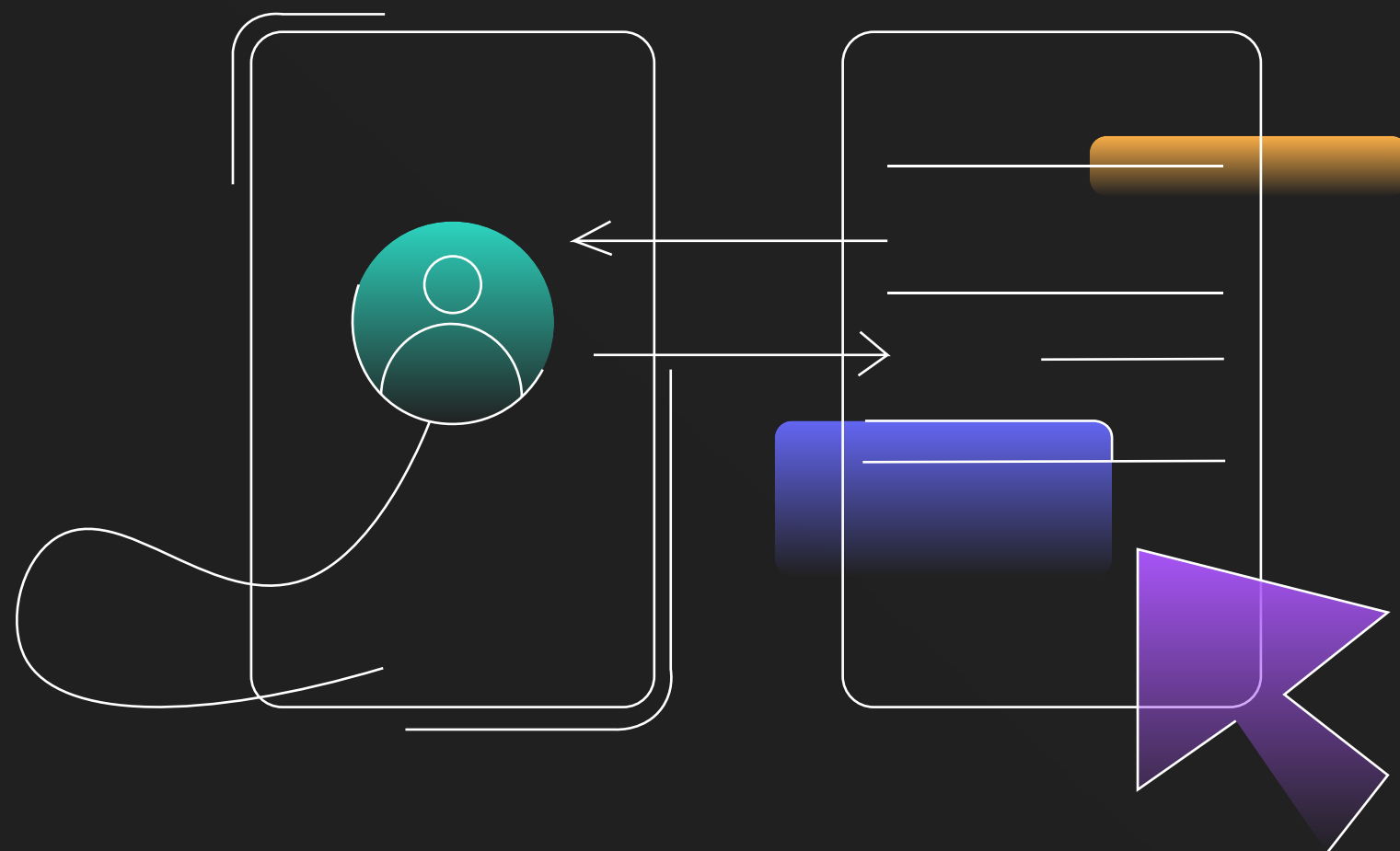

Understand UX Design

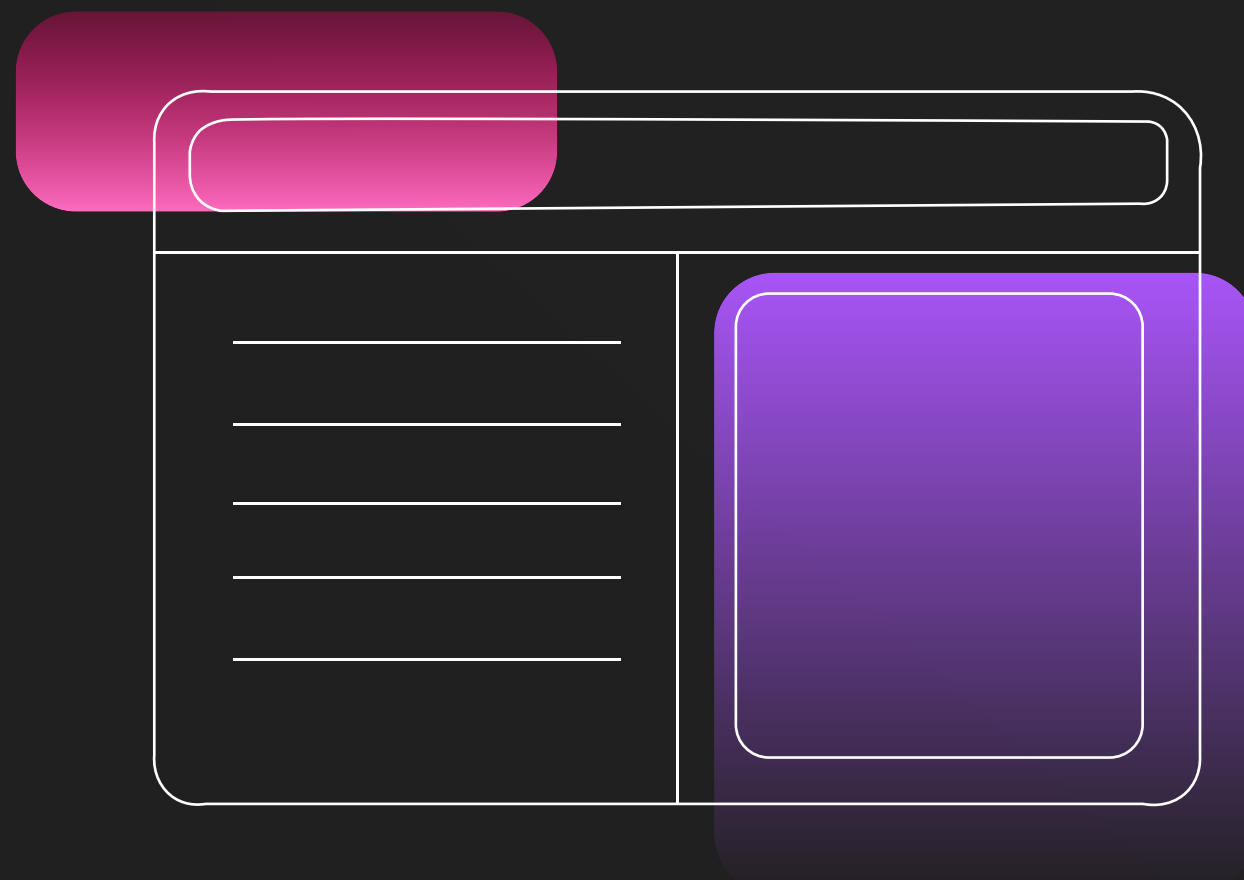

Areas of UI Designs

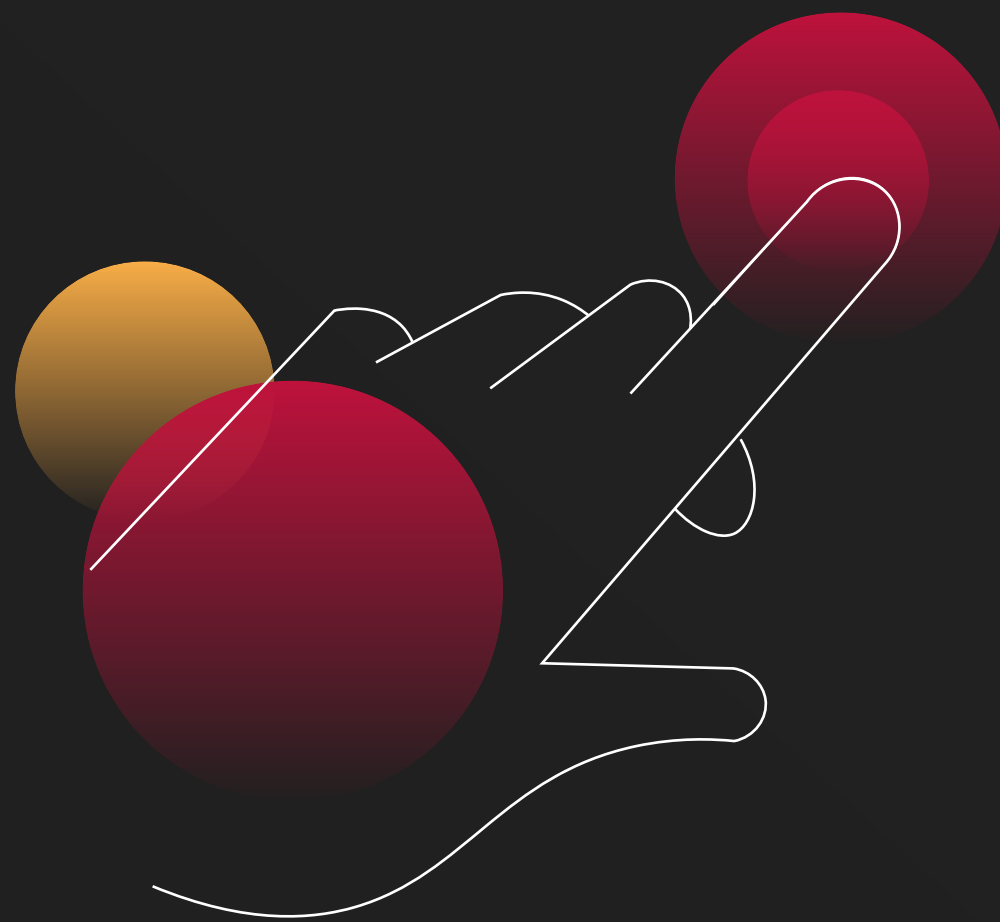
