

# 'Minecraft' Adds the Character Creator Option

Minecraft players are now getting more control over how their avatar looks. The most recent beta build features the option to create a character that will let you tweak the body shape, hairstyle, skin tone and color, facial hair and eyes. You can choose from more than 100 free items as well as other creations by the Minecraft team are available for purchase.

The beta is only accessible via Xbox One, Windows 10 and Android for now. It will launch on Minecraft Earth and Bedrock versions of the game, including Nintendo Switch and iOS, once the beta is over. You can still make custom skins on Windows 10 or mobile.

The customization option is a great addition, and it follows the tradition of many games (such as many RPGs) which allow players to customize their characters to look how they like. Many other titles such as Fortnite, offer custom character items for sale too. Nfo. So Although Minecraft has been selling skins and textures made by the community for a while however, it's still interesting see developers selling their own virtual items.
