Help spread the word about stranded dolphins by creating a masterpiece (and slogan if feeling creative) to showcase an important dolphin awareness topic:

Dolphins strand for a reason and should never be pushed back into the water!
Report strandings in Texas to 1-800-9MAMMAL!

Dolphins strand for a reason (e.g., sick, injured, weak, or entangled). Pushing a stranded dolphin back into the water delays needed help for the dolphin, puts it at risk for further harm, and may result in the dolphin stranding again. If you see a stranded dolphin in Texas, immediately call 1-800-9MAMMAL (1-800-962-6625) so our trained rescue team can give the animal its best chance at survival!

Prize

One winner will receive the opportunity to participate in a mock dolphin rescue program with TMMSN either in person at our Rehabilitation and Research Center in Galveston, TX, or online! The selected winner will be eligible to invite up to 20 friends (for in-person) to experience the program with!

Rules

- Artist must be within the ages of 0-14 upon submission
- Only one original art piece per child may be submitted
- To enter contest, email a PDF of the artwork, completed submission form, and a picture of the artist with their artwork (optional) to evinten@tmmsn.org by March 24, 2023 at 11:59pm for a chance to win
- One winner will be chosen based on originality, use of awareness topic, and slogan creativity (if applicable)
- If selected as the winner, travel to and from the TMMSN Rehabilitation and Research Center is at the expense of said winner and accompanying parties
- You do not have to live in Texas to enter the contest
- Winner will be contacted directly and announced via our social media channels
